Day 1: God Began the Work (Ephesians 2:10)

<u>Scripture:</u> "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them." – Ephesians 2:10

Day 3: It's Working for Your Good (Romans 8:28)

<u>Scripture:</u> "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose." – Romans 8:28

Reflection: Remember that every circumstance, whether joyful or challenging, is being woven together for your good by God. Reflect on past experiences where God has brought good out of difficult situations.

<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, thank You for working all things together for my good. Help me to trust Your purpose and see Your hand in every situation. In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.

Day 4: God Has a Purpose and Plan for Our Lives (Jeremiah 29:11)

Scripture: "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope." – Jeremiah 29:11

Reflection: God's thoughts toward you are filled with peace and hope. Reflect on His promises and embrace the future He has planned for you, knowing it is filled with hope.

<u>Prayer:</u> Thank You, Lord, for Your plans of peace and hope for my life. Help me to embrace Your future with confidence and trust in Your plans. In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.

Day 5: Everything is Working Together for Your Good (Romans 8:28)

<u>Scripture:</u> "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose." – Romans 8:28

Reflection: God's orchestration of your life is a masterpiece. Reflect on how each piece, even the challenging ones, is working together for your ultimate good.

<u>Prayer:</u> Father, thank You for weaving together every part of my life for good. Grant me the wisdom to see Your hand at work in every situation. In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.

Day 6: Forget Those Things Which Are Behind (Philippians 3:12-14)

<u>Scripture:</u> "Forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." – Philippians 3:13-14

Reflection: Let go of past regrets and failures. Focus on the promises and opportunities that lie ahead. God's grace covers your past and His mercy renews your future.

<u>Prayer:</u> Lord, help me to let go of the past and reach forward to the future You have for me. Strengthen me to press toward the goal of Your upward call. In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.

Day 7: God Doesn't Throw Us Away When We Fall Short (Psalm 103:8)

<u>Scripture:</u> "The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in mercy." – Psalm 103:8

<u>Reflection:</u> Unlike humans, God's grace and mercy are boundless. Reflect on His forgiveness and how He continues to work in you despite your shortcomings.

<u>Prayer:</u> Thank You, Lord, for Your endless mercy and grace. Help me to rest in Your forgiveness and continue to grow in Your love. In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.
